For this practice quiz, you will watch the above video, *Seis Meses Sin El Rastro*. The video discusses the current conflict between sellers of the Rastro (*los comerciantes*), Madrid's oldest and biggest open-air market, and the city government (*el Ayuntamiento*). Before answering the quiz questions, please watch the video **at least two times through**. The first section of questions are practice questions on the subjunctive; the second section of questions are based on the above video; the third section of the question asks you to apply what you watched in the video with what you have learned about the subjunctive.

OJO: In this video, everyone speaks very fast with a Madrileñan accent. Don't worry so much about every word, try to get the overall meaning of what's happening between the *comerciantes* of the Rastro and *el Ayuntamiento*. Note that you can read the captions to the video while listening to the spoken Spanish.

The city government has proposed a variety of measures for the Rastro to re-open, but you have strong doubts about whether they will work to both prevent the spread of COVID and ensure el Rastro's vendors can make a living. These measures include moving the market completely out of La Latina, the neighborhood where it's happened for 300 years, and reduces the number of vendors who can sell their wares to 25% of the usual. You decide to write a letter to el Ayuntamiento expressing your doubts.

In your letter, include the following:

- Introduction (who are you? why are you writing?)
- 3 - 4 doubts about the Rastro's re-opening using the subjunctive
- information from the video *Seis Meses Sin Rastro*
- Closing (Sinceramente, your name)

The letter should be 75 - 100 words.
